TO THE HONORABLE, THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY,
IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA:

The petition of *Denis Boyle*

HUMBLY SHEWETH:

That your petitioner is a native of *Ireland*
and was heretofore a subject of *Victoria Queen of Great Britain & Ireland* and
that he has resided within the limits and under the jurisdiction of the United States of America, for
five years, and within the State of Pennsylvania one year, and that the *said Denis Boyle*
declared his intention to become a citizen of the United
States in this Court on the 8th day of September
1886 as by annexed certificate

appears:—that he will support the Constitution of the United States; and that he doth absolutely and
entirely renounce, and forever abjure all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, and
sovereignty whatever, and particularly, to

Victoria Queen of Great
Britain & Ireland

whereof he was heretofore a subject. Your petitioner, therefore, prays that he may be admitted to
become a citizen of the United States of America.

I, *Denis Boyle* do swear, that the facts set forth in this my petition, are true,
and that I will support the Constitution of the United States; and that I do absolutely and entirely
renounce, and abjure forever, all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, and sovereignty
whatever; and particularly, do absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure forever, all allegiance
and fidelity to *Victoria Queen of Great Britain & Ireland*
whereof I was heretofore a subject.

within the United States, he has behaved as a man of good moral character, attached to the Constitu-
tion of the United States, and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the same.
